

Activity 2: Install and configure FTP services on a server

1. Install the ProFTPD service on your Linux virtual machine (guest computer).
2. Install WinSCP FTP client on your host computer.
3. Using the FTP client on the host, make an FTP connection to the server's IP address and log in using your primary account on the server (ie. your name).
4. Modify the appropriate FTP server configuration file to "jail" users to their home directories.
5. Create a new FTP user and make its home directory match the web server's default content directory.
6. Test FTP connections from the host computer with both user accounts (your primary and the new FTP user). Confirm that users are "jailed" to their respective home directories.
